===== Accidental Release Measures =====

Spill Release Procedures:WEAR PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENTS. ELIMINATE IGNITION SOURCES (H2 MAY BE GENERATED). VENTILATE AREA. DIKE SPILL. CONTAIN/ABSORB SPILLS WITH DRY SAND, EARTH, VERMICULITE. CAREFULLY N  
EUTRALIZE WITH SODA ASH, S ODIUM BICARBONATE, LIME. DO NOT FLUSH TO SEWER.

===== Handling and Storage =====

Handling and Storage Precautions:STORE IN COOL PLACE AWAY FROM INCOMPATIBLE MATERIALS. WEAR GLOVES WHILE HANDLING. TO DILUTE, ALWAYS ADD WATER CAUTIOUSLY TO ACID, NOT ACID TO WATER.  
Other Precautions:AVOID BREATHING VAPORS OR MISTS. DO NOT GET IN EYES, ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING. WASH THOROUGHLY AFTER HANDLING AND BEFORE EATING OR DRINKING. REMOVE CONTAMINATED CLOTHING PROMPTLY. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

===== Exposure Controls/Personal Protection =====

Respiratory Protection:NON REQUIRED UNDER NORMAL CONDITIONS. IF MISTING IS OCCURRING, USE NIOSH-APPROVED SUPPLIED AIR RESPIRATOR, OR AN AIR-PURIFYING RESPIRATOR FOR ACID.
